Cardiovascular/Cerebrovascular

- □ Cor Pulmonale, Acute
- □ CVA, Stroke, Cerebral Infarct or Hemorrhage
- □ Cerebral Edema
- □ Coma
- □ Endocarditis or Myocarditis, Acute
- □ Myocardial Infarction, Acute
- □ Pulmonary Embolism, *Acute*

Respiratory & Infectious Disease

- □ Aspiration Bronchitis, Aspiration Pneumonia
- □ HIV Disease
- □ Peritonitis
- □ Pneumonia, Including viral
- □ Pulmonary Edema, Acute, Non-cardiogenic
- □ Respiratory Failure, *Acute*
- □ Respiratory Insufficiency
